One Love has become a multi-faceted animal organization excelling in the arenas of foster homes, adoptions, transports and ultimately, rescue. While some shelters save animals because they represent low-cost adoptability, we have stepped in for many neglected,

abused and abandoned animals. With the love and care they have received from our dedicated network of foster homes and volunteers, we helped them become happy, healthy, ADOPTABLE pets. One Love rescues the overlooked, medically challenged and those left behind. With One Love, every animal is valued and is cared for until their recovery is complete, and a home is found. Yes, there have been heartaches, but we were able to show love and devotion, even at the end.

No organization can sustain this level of work without the financial backing from dedicated supporters. We have been so fortunate to be well received and supported in our community. In 2015, 87% of the funds raised, adoption donations and financial gifts went to support the animals in our care. We continue to guide the Savannah area toward becoming a no kill community. We strive to build programs that will assist

animals to be adopted successfully and placed into forever, loving homes. We persevere in teaching the public about the importance of spaying and neutering pets, as well as showing respect to all animals.

I feel fortunate that our small, but growing grass roots organization is making a difference each day in the lives of homeless animals in Savannah. We are on the way to achieving our 2016 goals: 71 animals have already been adopted into loving homes and 20 lives have been transported to the safety of no-kill shelters. We hope our financial support remains strong, our foster care network continues to grow and our loyal volunteers remain engaged allowing One Love to save even more lives.

Our dream remains the same, that our shelters will one day be empty because every animal will have a home.






One Love Animal Rescue volunteers, foster families and their charges gathered for the annual Woof Woof Run fundraiser.
