Letter from the CEO

Ask any seasoned rescuer and they will tell you that 2022 was a hard year. After record breaking adoptions during the pandemic, most of us saw record breaking numbers of surrendered and abandoned pets. It felt like all of the progress the rescue community had made in the past 15 years was just gone; however, there was one notable difference - a strong community based on mutual respect and collaboration.

Rescue cannot be completed in a silo. This past year we worked with both our local rescue partners and our national ones. We made new connections. We resolved together to do what could be done - and we aimed high.

We worked with 9 partners to transport cats and dogs to groups across the country that had space. We workshopped surrendered and abandoned pets among our community rescues to find placement. Our incredible volunteers came together to market our adoptable animals, take those in boarding on outings, and transport others to adoption events. Our loving fosters found space for another cat or dog in their homes and their hearts until they could be transported or adopted.

We also increased the capacity of our community program, Operation Pet Solutions (OPS). This program is a two pronged approach that addresses pet overpopulation and prevents loved pets from being surrendered. Through OPS we offer free and low-cost spay and neuter surgeries for owned pets, preventing unplanned litters, as well as behavioral and health issues. The OPS program also provides loving pet parents with pet food, litter, collars and leashes, and dog houses in times of need so that they can keep their pet instead of surrendering it to us or another local rescue.

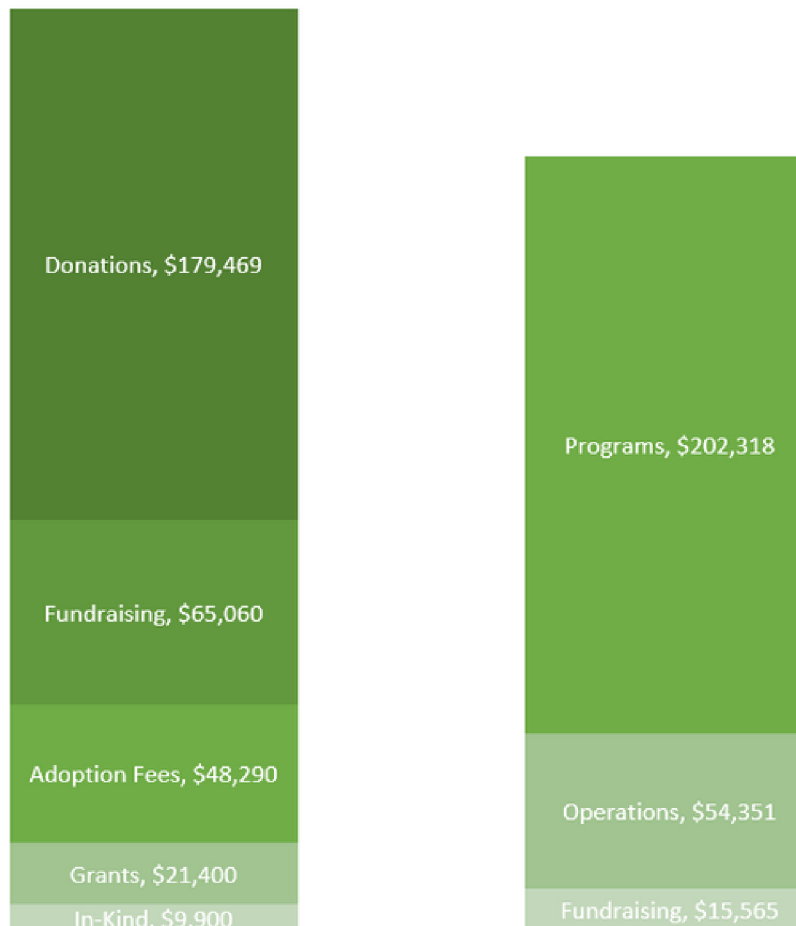
This work is hard because it is so necessary. One day, I hope that it isn't, but until that day, I am honored to be working alongside each and every one of you.
